Paper Proposal Requirements

The organizing committee will organize a competitive selection of reports. The main selection criteria are the originality and relevance of the submissions issues.

Requirements for papers:

5-8 pages in A4, the text should be made in the editor, MS Word (2003, XP) in the doc. font Times New Roman, size 14, half interval, all images in GIF or JPG (related). Tables in the text must be located within the boundaries of the page. Formatting the table name: font Times New Roman, bold, size 14, centered. At the end

point of the table name is not assigned. Contents of the table - the font Times New Roman, size 12, spacing - single. References are given in the text in square brackets, eg [1, pp. 15]. The reports are accepted for participation in Russian/English with Abstracts in English and Russian languages (up to 400 characters).

Arrangement of the report:

- The name of the center line in capital letters (size 14);
- a line single line spacing in bold with the right alignment: Name (Ivan Ivanov) of author (authors);
- a line single line spacing in italics: country, city, organization;
- a line single line spacing with full justification no indent: summary in Russian and English, with an interval between annotations;
- a line half interval: the text of the report with full justification and indentation of 1.25 cm;
- a line single line spacing - references in alphabetical order of the font Times New Roman, size 12, spacing - single, decoration, GOST R 7.0.5-2008.
